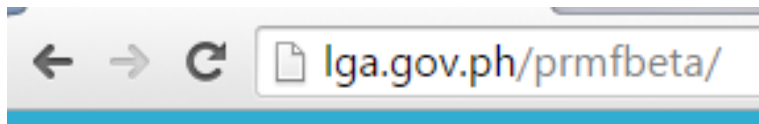

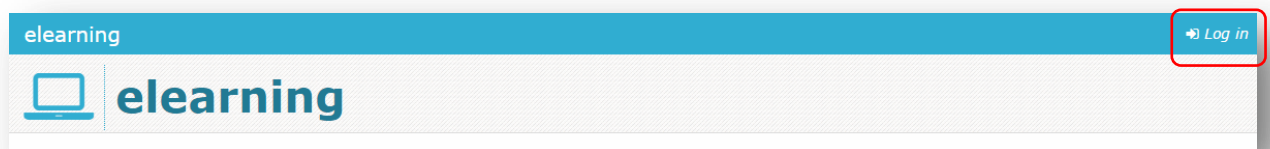
A. To access your Online Course

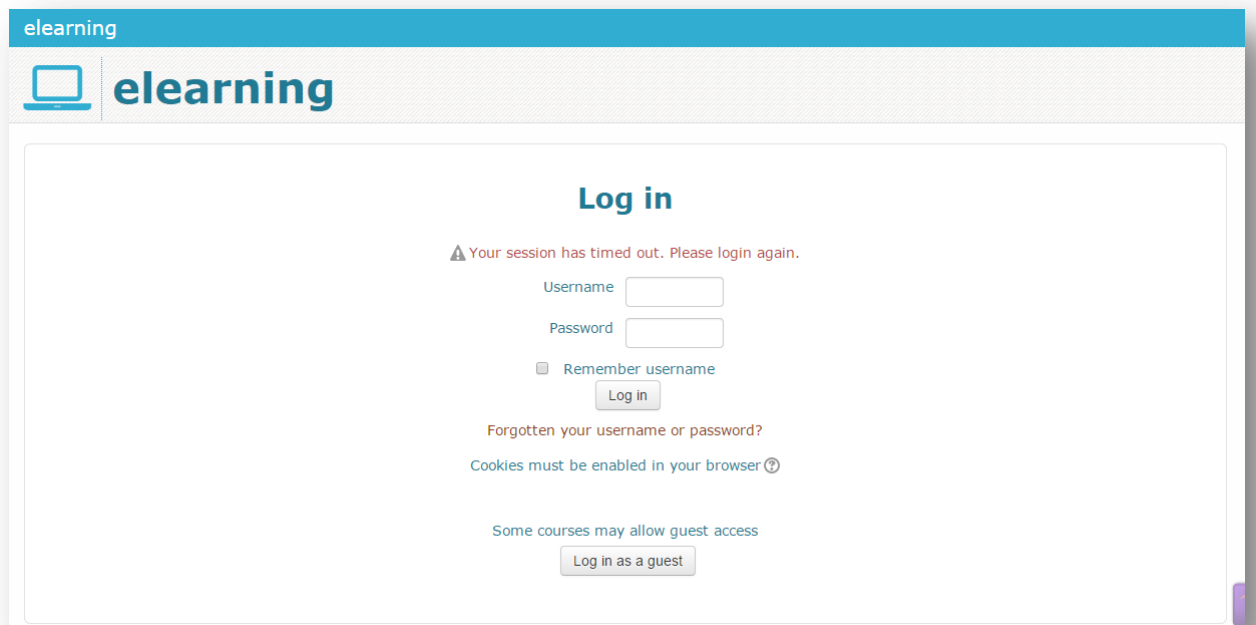


B. To log-in

- Click the Log-in button on the upper right of the webpage

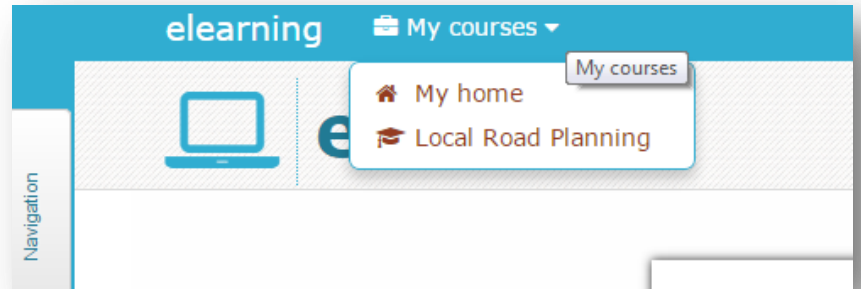

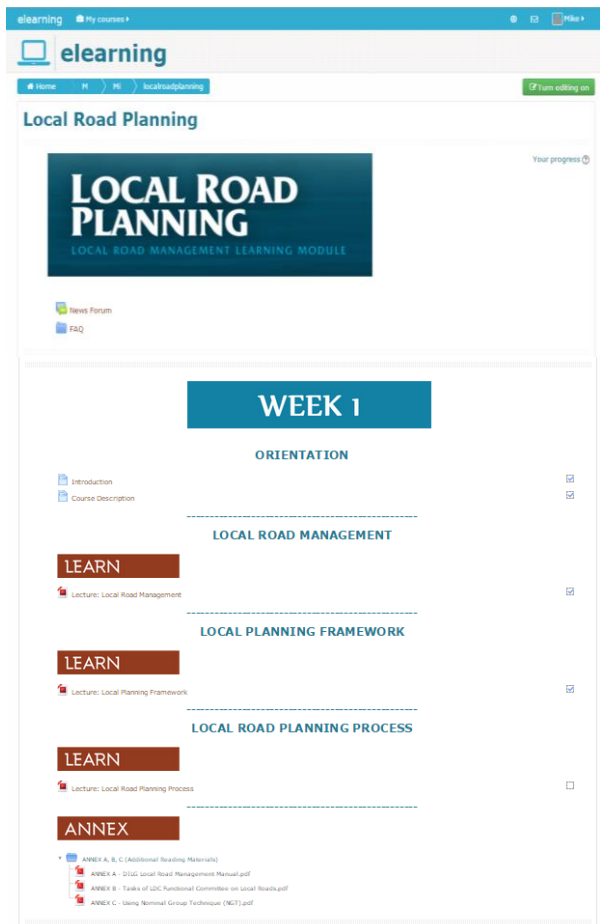

Tasks of LDC Functional Committee on Local Roads

For LRNDP preparation, a functional committee on local roads can be set up under the sectoral committee on Physical and Infrastructure Development. The multi-sectoral members come from both public and private organizations (see table below) and serve in the committee for the duration of the LRNDP preparation.

Table 1 Suggested composition of the functional committee on local roads, LDC

Using Nominal Group Technique (NGT)

It often happens that in selecting which problem or solution needs to be worked on, the person with the loudest voice or the most authority in the group ends up making the choice. And so the selected problem or solution fails to get the ownership of the group, and leads to lackluster commitment from the rest of the group. NGT offers a way of giving an equal chance for all group members to have a voice in the selection process. The steps are:

1. Allow everyone to write down or say the problem s/he feels is most important. If unwritten, have the opinion written down as they are being communicated.
2. Collect all written opinions once finished. Post them in a visible space for everyone to see.
3. Check with the team to ensure that the same entry is not written twice (but maybe in slightly different wording). If there is repetition of ideas, combine them into one item.
4. Ask the members to write down on a piece of paper the letters corresponding to the number of items the team produced. For example, if they ended up with five problem statements, everyone would write "A" through "E" on the paper.
5. Make sure that each problem statement has a letter in front of it. Ask the team members to vote on which problem is most important, then write "5" next to the letter. For example, the problem list may look like this:
 - A. Space
 - B. Safety
 - C. Housekeeping
 - D. Quality going down
 - E. No preventive maintenance
